



APPLICATION FOR SHORT-TERM USE OF TAHOE STATE-OWNED PARCELS

Urban lots managed by the Nevada Division of State Lands (NDSL) were acquired with funds authorized by the Tahoe Basin Act and subsequent programs. These parcels are recognized as environmentally sensitive and management of these parcels as conservation areas is an important part of the State’s commitment to preserving the water quality and clarity of Lake Tahoe. State-owned urban lots are visited each year by NDSL to conduct forest health and hazardous fuels reduction treatments to protect the soils, native vegetation and wildlife habitat. Use of these parcels for snow storage or other short-term uses may be permitted provided that the natural landscape is not disturbed and NDSL determines that there will be no environmental damage to the property. Property owners may not access or do work on the urban lots without prior authorization from NDSL.
