



The urban lots managed by the Nevada Division of State Lands were acquired with funds authorized by the Tahoe Basin Act and subsequent programs. These parcels are recognized as environmentally sensitive and management of these parcels as conservation areas is an important part of the State’s commitment to preserving the water quality and clarity of Lake Tahoe. Use of these parcels for snow storage may be permitted provided that the natural landscape is not disturbed and State Lands determines that there will be no environmental damage to the property.
